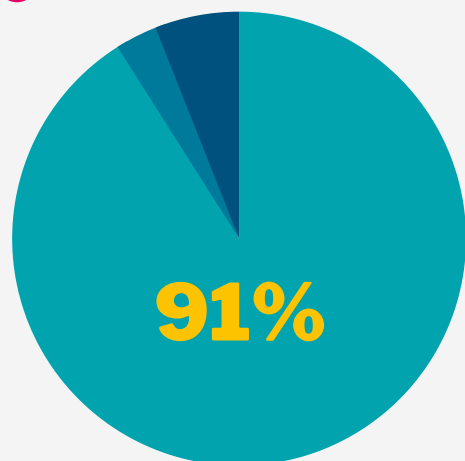


# UNIVERSITY TECHNICAL COLLEGES Destinations 2021

Students leaving UTCs at age 18 in July 2021 achieved impressive destinations compared with national averages\*



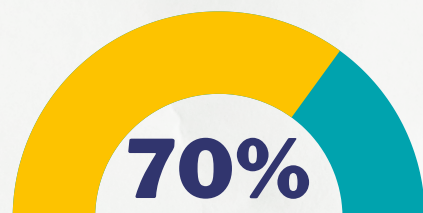
**91% of UTC leavers stayed in education, employment or training (apprenticeship), compared with 88% nationally.**

**3% are NEET (not in employment, education or training) or not known, compared with 12% nationally.**  
**6% took gap years, left the country etc.**

## UNIVERSITY



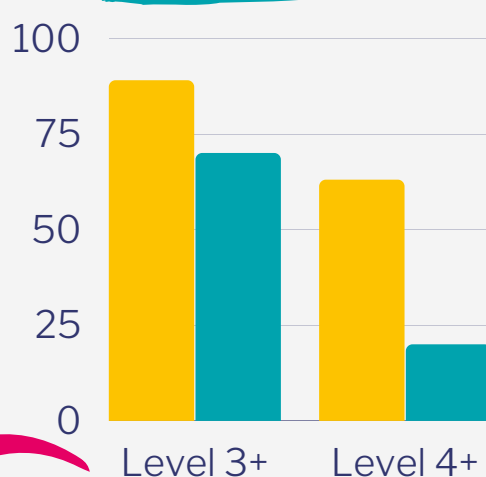
**55% of leavers at 18 years of age started at university,**  
compared with 50% nationally



**Of these, 70% started a STEM course at university.**  
The national average is only 42%.

## APPRENTICESHIPS

**19% of students leaving at 18 years of age started an apprenticeship,**  
over three times the national average of 6%.



**A huge 89% of these students started an apprenticeship at Level 3+ compared with 70% nationally.**

**63% started an apprenticeship at Higher or Degree Level.**

This is more than three times the national average of 20%.

## EMPLOYMENT



**13% went straight into employment,**  
compared with 23% nationally.
